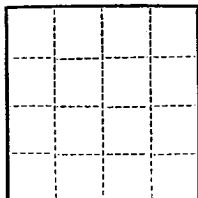

## DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 2200 feet. Rotary tools will be used to total depth. Casing will be set on top of pay. Pictured Cliffs pay section will be drilled with gas and Sandoil Fracked.

Size	Depth	Cement	Remarks
8-5/8"	100'	75	175% of calculated amount to circulate.
5-1/2"	2100'	75	100% of calculated amount to fill 600' above shoe.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
