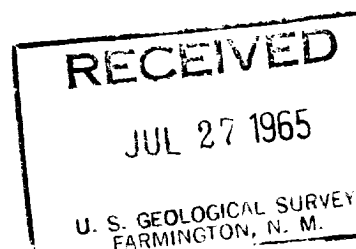

Instructions

for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal lands, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
