Subject: Bradenhead Water Sundry Notices and OCD Concurrence Submittal

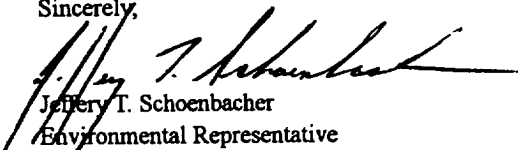
Dear Mr. Farrell:

I would like to thank you for your correspondence dated September 8, 1999, that documented BLM's conditions for providing Bradenhead water flows as a water source for livestock. The purpose of this correspondence is to provide you with the Sundry Notices for Huerfanito Unit #87, Huerfanito Unit #11, and Luthy #1.

Per your suggestion, the Sundry Notices contain the correct lease numbers and attached you will find a letter from Frank Chavez (OCD) that documents the position of this agency on the bradenhead flows. Regarding the Kah Des Pah #1R and Navajo Indian B #3, plans are being made to stop these flows and once I have the remedial plan time frames I will convey this information to your department. Furthermore, letters have also been sent to the grazing allottees that would utilize the water flows at the approved locations. Attached to these correspondences were BLM and Burlington Resources water use agreements that clarifies the conditions for continuing the water flows. After I receive the signed agreements, I will forward them to your department for the appropriate signatures.
