
October 21, 1960 - Spudded well at 10:00 p.m.

October 22, 1960 - After drilling to 370' K.B., set 11 joints (354.3') of 8-5/8" - 24# J-55 casing at 367.5' KB with 200 sacks cement - 2% calcium Chloride. Circulated to surface. Plug down at 10:15 A.M.

October 23, 1960 - 1200# pressure held for 30 minutes without decrease. Resumed drilling with rotary rig.
