*On July 2, 1962 your company filed with this office two sets of Form C-110 on the Huerfano Unit 60- 4 well in M-4-26N-9W.*

*This well had been temporarily operated by Mr. J. Glenn Turner, who dually completed the well in the Dakota and Gallup zones in early 1962. Forms C-110 filed by El Paso were filed for the purpose of properly designating the operator of this well as El Paso Natural Gas Company. However a dual completion order has never been applied for by either El Paso or Mr. Turner; therefore Form C-110 for the Gallup side of the well, which was the latest completion, should not have been approved.*

*We are, therefore, rescinding the approval of Form C-110 dated July 2, 1962 for the Gallup side of this dual completion. The Gallup completion should not be produced further until a dual completion order has been written by the Commission.*
