DETAILS OF WORK

On September 19, 1952, 4-1/2" casing was landed at 2157 feet and cemented with 150 sacks of cement. Plug down at 4:30 P.M., September 19, 1952. At 8:00 A.M., September 18, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1000 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Sixty-one feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

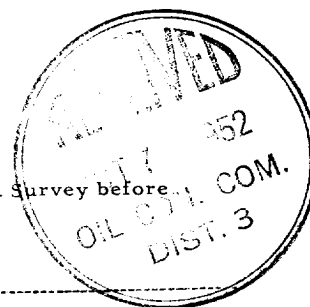
