DETAILS OF WORK

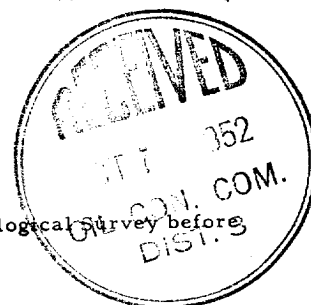
Well was drilled to a total depth of 2174 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 2065 to 2160 feet open with 259 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with cable tool rig and 1-1/2" tubing was landed at 2147 feet. Well shut in 24 hours. Shut in casing pressure 414 psi. After 3 hour blow down, well measured 116 MCF per 24 hours through 2" outlet with pitot tube September 22, 1952.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
