- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Huerfano Unit Well No. 109 located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Gallup Pool adjacent to the Angel Peak-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool adjacent to the Angel Peak-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

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PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single zone production in the interests of conservation.
