ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 4, 1994, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 12th day of August, 1994, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, J.K. Edwards Associates, Inc., seeks authority to utilize its Bengal "A" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the South and West lines (Unit K) of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, to dispose of produced water into the Gallegos-Gallup Associated Pool through the perforated interval from approximately 4993 feet to 5174 feet.

- (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.
- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.

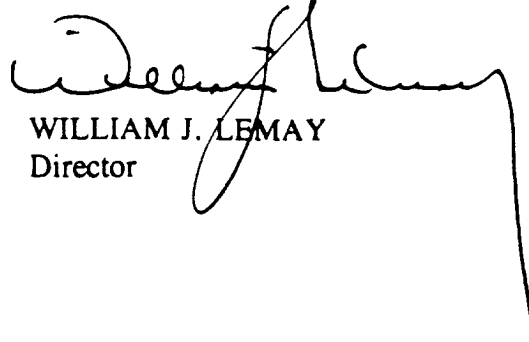
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
