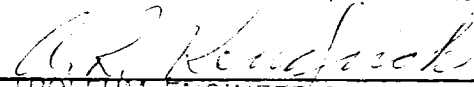

Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains. The *Agrobacterium* strains were grown in the medium containing 100 mg/l of tetracycline. The cell concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension was adjusted to 100, 200, 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800, 900, and 1000 cells/ml. The transformation efficiency was determined by the number of transformants per 100 cells of the *Agrobacterium* suspension. The data were expressed as the mean $\pm$ SD of three independent experiments.
