DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a total depth of 2130 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 2086 to 2130 feet open with 326 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with gas and 1-1/4" tubing was landed at 2077 feet. Well went in 84 hours. Shut in casing pressure 430 psi. After 3-hour blow down well measured 396 MCF per 24 hours through 2" outlet with pitot tube August 14, 1952. Well was shut in for pipe line connection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
