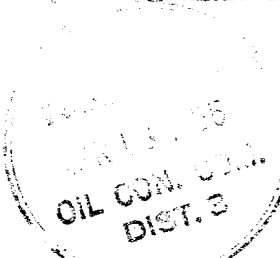

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Spudded well at 3:00 P.M. on April 7, 1955. Drilled to total depth of 105' from K.B., or 97' from ground. Ran three joints of 8-5/8" OD 24# J-55 casing to total depth. On April 8th, cemented with 50 sacks neat cement and 50 sacks "Pozmix S". Circulated cement to surface.

Moved cable tool rig off. Awaiting rotary rig to continue drilling. - 4/8/55.
