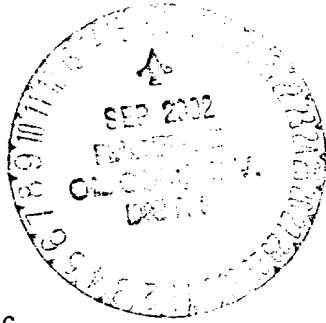

## AMENDED COMMINGLING ORDER PC-1026-A

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle the following pools and acreage within Section 1, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Blanco LS Wells No. 13  
South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs (Prorated Gas – 72439)

API No. 30-045-06857  
NE/4 Dedication

Blanco LS Wells No. 14  
Blanco-Mesaverde (Prorated Gas – 72319)

API No. 30-045-06856  
N/2 Dedication

Production and sales allocation shall be determined by periodic well tests. Water and oil production shall not be commingled. **Compressor fuel gas usage shall be allocated according to well production rates.**

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

REMARKS: The commingled natural gas production shall be delivered to a gas meter located on the lease.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.
