DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to temporarily abandon this well as follows:

1. Cut out iron retainer in 1 1/2" intermediate casing, and squeeze off top of liner and Mesa Verde perforations at 5322-5406 with cement.
2. Run 1 foot cement plug on top of retainer, leave hole with water.
3. Install metal plate on broomhead.
