Gentlemen:

Your request for installation of subject LACT equipment has been approved as shown on your sketch and as described in your specifications furnished us with your letter dated September 15, 1966. You may use this letter in your application to the State of New Mexico as concurrence on our part to accept custody transfer of crude from the subject lease through positive displacement meters.

We have examined the flow diagram and find it acceptable; however, final acceptance of the installation will be contingent upon our successful field proving of the measuring, quality control, sampling and safety components. We assume the B&W monitor will be of the fail-safe type; that is, the skid will be made inoperative in the event of a component failure.

Four Corners Pipe Line will provide without charge the personnel and equipment necessary for proving of subject facilities; however, the producer shall be responsible for maintaining the equipment in good working order.
