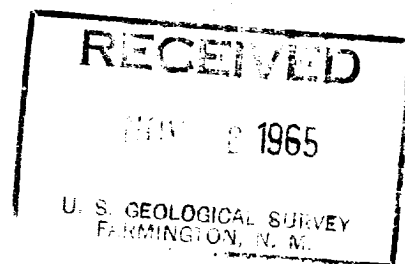

Casing was run in this well August 4, 1965. An attempt was made to complete it in the Lower Gallup sand through perforations at 5170-5176' KB/ES. The zone was sand oil fractured with 35,000 lb. sand in 28,014 gal. oil on 8-9-65. Pumping equipment was installed. On 11-6-65 the well was making 2 BLO per day and 12 BWPD. About 316 barrels load oil has not been recovered and no new oil ever produced. No other possible producing zone exists; therefore, it is proposed that the well be plugged and abandoned as follows: (1) spot 103' cement plug (12 sacks) from PED 5235' to 5132' KB across Gallup perforations; (2) shoot off 5 1/2" casing at about 2000' and pull; (3) spot 103' cement plug (12 sacks) across pipe stub from 1950' to 2053'; (4) spot 10 sack cement plug in top of surface casing; (5) erect dry hole marker and clean up location.

The hole will be filled with heavy mud between cement plugs.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
