Drilled 7 7/8" hole 7277'. Ran 5 1/2" 17# & 15.5# J-55 casing to 7270'. Cemented thru shoe with 200 sx. cement and 100 cu. ft. Strata-crete. Plug down 6:00 p.m. 12/23/61. Cemented through stage collar at 2869' with 150 sx. 50/50 Pozmix cement. Plug down 10:00 p.m. 12/23/61.

12/27/61: Drilled out to 7254', tested to 2500 PSI - held OK.
