DETAILS OF WORK

Logs indicate this well will probably be productive from both the Dakota and the Gallup formations, and it is therefore desired to make a dual completion:

Perforate the Dakota: 6,412 - 6,548, sand water fracture, and run 2-1/16" tubing for production from the Dakota.

Perforate the Gallup: 5,728 - 5,790 and 5,824-5840. Sand oil fracture, and run 2-1/16" tubing for production from the Gallup formation.
