ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION.

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 25, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Uts, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 3rd day of May, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Uts, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDINGS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, J. Glenn Turner, seeks permission to complete his Ballard Well No. 11-15 located in Unit D of Section 15, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, NMMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool and in an undesignated Gallup oil pool with the production of gas from the Dakota formation and the production of oil from the Gallup formation to be through parallel strings of 2 1/16-inch tubing.

(3) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, J. Glenn Turner, is hereby authorized to complete his Ballard Well No. 11-15 located in Unit D of Section 15, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, NMNM, San Juan County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool and in an undesignated Gallup oil pool with the production of gas from the Dakota formation and the production of oil from the Gallup formation to be through parallel strings of 2 1/16-inch tubing.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That the applicant shall conduct packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota formation, and at such other times as the Secretary-Director of the Commission may prescribe.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
