Cement 2nd stage w/850 cu. ft. 50-50 Pozmix Class "C". Plug down 1:00 P.M. 6/30/67. Cement 3rd stage w/1000 cu. ft. of 50-50 Pozmix Class "C". Plug down 2:00 P.M. 6/30/67. Stage collars @2497 ft. and 4944 ft. R.K.B.
3. Rigged up completion unit 7/3/67
4. Picked up 1 1/2" tbg. Drilled stage collars @2497 ft. & 4944 ft. R.K.B. Cleaned out to P.B.T.D. of 6960 ft. R.K.B.
5. Pressure tested 1 1/2" casing w/3500 psi for 15 min. Test OK.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
