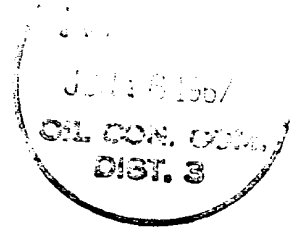

Gentlemen:

Pubco Petroleum Corporation hereby submits its Application for Administrative approval for an unorthodox well location proposed to be located 990 feet from the West line and 330 feet from the South line of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That the proposed unorthodox location is being so located due to the topography conditions in the area.
2. That the proposed unorthodox location is located on a Standard Gas proration unit comprising the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, owned entirely by Pubco Petroleum Corporation.
3. That the proposed unorthodox location will be identified as the Pubco Federal No. 16 well to be drilled to a depth sufficient to penetrate the Dakota formation.
4. That by copy of this letter of Application all operators owning interests in (a) the section in which the unorthodox location is situated, and (b) acreage offsetting the section in which the unorthodox location is situated, are notified by Registered Mail of this proposed unorthodox well location.



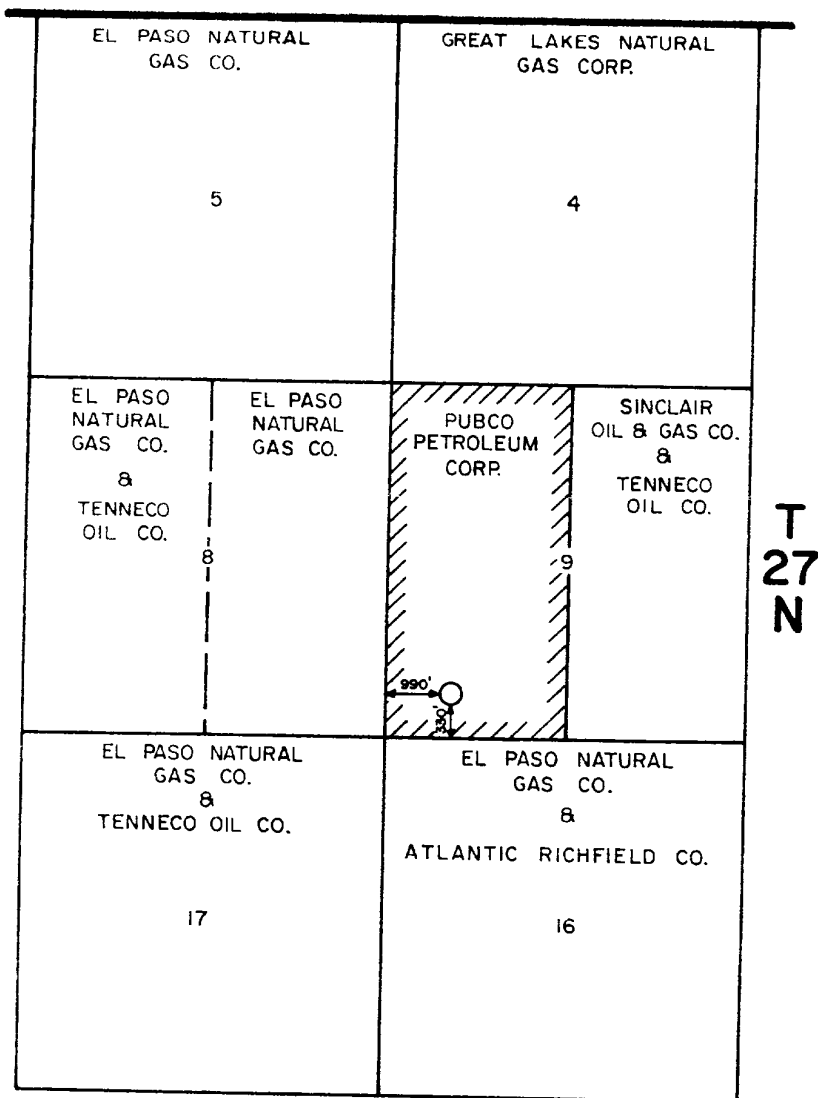
