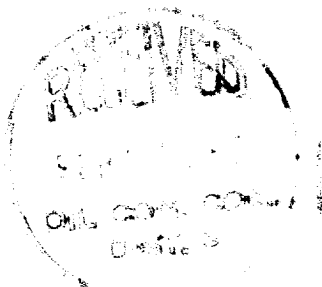

Well was spudded 12-28-67. 8-5/8" casing set at 74' and cemented with 40 sacks Class "A" cement with 21 CaCl. Ran logs at 836'. 3-1/2" casing set at 836' and cemented with 250 sacks Class "A" cement with 21 CaCl. Tested casing to 3000 psi for 15 minutes OK. Drilled 836-810' at one foot intervals. Shubbbed and recovered 14 barrels drill water and no new water or oil. Drilled 810-815' at one foot intervals. Shubbbed and recovered 16 barrels drill water, 25 barrels new water and no oil. Shut in one hour. Shubbbed and recovered 3 barrels new water and no oil. Drilled to 1111'. Ran Gamma Ray and IES logs. No show oil or gas. Rig released 1-4-68. Shubbbed and recovered mud and water, no show of oil. Shut in for 12 hours. Shubbbed 50 barrels water and no oil or gas. Well shut in 1-10-68.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
