

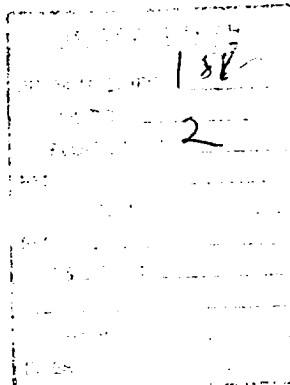

Dear Mr. Townsend:

In answer to your letter dated January 21, 1993, [your reference NM NM 622 et al. (WC) 3162.3-2 (070)] the following action has been or will be taken on the referenced wells.

1. Chaco Plant 12 was sold at auction Dec. of 1992 to:  
Oro Petro Drlg. Inc. (Robert O. Palmer)  
4560 Beltline Road, Suite 424  
Dallas, Texas 75244  
Final transfer of the well will take place when all bonding requirements are complete. Oro Petro. Drlg. has been notified of your letter.
2. Chaco Plant 20 has the same status as Chaco Plant 12.
3. The Oxnard 1 <sup>A-11-27N-8W</sup> has not been connected to EPNG since 1979. We will test and evaluate well for production or possible plugging during the spring of 1993.
4. The Oxnard 2 <sup>P.11-27N-8W</sup> has a suspected hole in the tubing. It will be repaired and tested during the spring of 1993.
5. The Nassau 7 <sup>A-11-27N-8W</sup> has no production history since I was named Production Superintendent for Nassau Resources. It will be tested and evaluated during the spring of 1993.
