A-34-27-8 Hammond #1 and Hammond #2 ^{*A-34-27-8*} - Compressor furnished by Atomi

If these wells will produce through a compressor they will be restored to production. If not, Nassau will explore other options (P & A, sale, and etc.).

The following wells will be tested in July as soon as the compressor on the Hammonds is available:

A-11-27-8 - Oxnard #1 and ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~

We are now trying to produce the Nassau #7 well. If pumper cannot sustain production we plan to swab the well in, and again try to produce the well.
