

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A, Wynn Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 19, 1951, for permission to drill completion the Largo Field, Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 11, Township 33 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Chaco formation and the Blanco-Mesaville Pool.

For on the 19th day of June 1951, the Secretary-
Director finds

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset wells have been duly notified and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste nor injury to other wells.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Wynn Oil Company, be and the same be hereby authorized to drill completion the Largo Field, Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 11, Township 33 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Chaco formation and the Blanco-Mesaville Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

FOUNDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete operations and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

FOUNDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That completion of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
