



THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2115

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1974, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 202, located in Unit I, Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation.

Now, on this 20th day of June, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 202, located in Unit I, Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8-inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

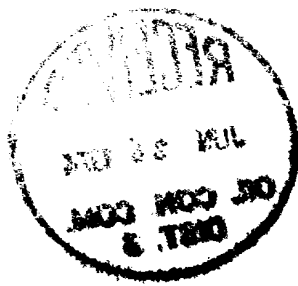
**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

Under the provisions of Rule 12-A, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1974, application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1974, for permission to drill a well in the San Juan 28-7 Unit (Well No. 202, located in Unit I, Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NEM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico), in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Albino-Placeres 28-7 Unit and from the Ochoa formation.

Now, on this 10th day of June, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 12-A of the Commission's rules and regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset wells.
- (3) That the waiting period as provided by said rule may be waived.
- (4) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste of gas or other resources.
- (5) That the completion of the proposed well completion will be in accordance with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, the New Mexico Oil Company, be and it is hereby authorized to drill a well in the San Juan 28-7 Unit (Well No. 202, located in Unit I, Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NEM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico), in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Albino-Placeres 28-7 Unit and from the Ochoa formation through perforations of 2 7/8-inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 12-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take proper safety tests and operations and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That completion of this case is hereby authorized for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
