

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2116

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1974, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 201, located in Unit P, Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation.

Now, on this 20th day of June, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 201, located in Unit P, Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8-inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

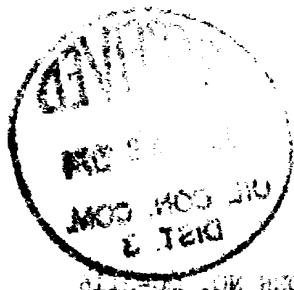
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1937, for permission to drill a well in the San Juan 28-7 Unit West No. 201, located in Unit 1, Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Rita-Blanco-Blanco Oil Pool and from the Santa Rita-Blanco-Blanco Oil Pool.

Now, on this 20th day of June, 1937, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset wells;
- (3) That the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and it shall be hereby authorized to drill a well in the San Juan 28-7 Unit West No. 201, located in Unit 1, Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Santa Rita-Blanco-Blanco Oil Pool and from the Santa Rita-Blanco-Blanco Oil Pool through a series of 2 1/2 inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper steps to insure proper completion and shut-in thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That completion of this lease is hereby required for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
