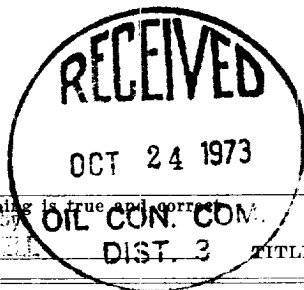

Drilling continued to a depth of 6247' where on September 8, 1973, Core No. 1 was cut from 6247-6279'. Cut 32' but recovered only 27-1/2' limestone bleeding oil from intervals 6260-1/2 - 6268-1/2' and 6272-6274'. Core No. 2 was cut from 6279-6332'. Cut 53' and recovered only 43-1/2' limestone bleeding oil from intervals 6279-82' and 6283-85'.

Drilling continued to a TD of 6437' where on September 10, 1973, the 7" casing was set at 6433' with a DV tool at 3796'. The first stage was cemented with 350 sacks Class "A" cement with 6% Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack followed by 225 sacks Class "A" Neat cement. Circulated contaminated mud. Cemented second stage with 675 sacks Class "A" cement with 6% Gel and 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack followed by 75 sacks Class "A" Neat cement. Circulated contaminated mud. Drilled DV tool and cleaned out to PBE 6405'.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
