The attached application for Temporary Abandonment for the subject well indicates possible casing failure.


Rule 108 requires the operator of a well with defective casing to proceed with diligence to repair or to plug the well.

Temporary abandonment is granted until October 31, 1976, at which time remedial or plugging action must be commenced to avoid a hearing to justify the well remaining in violation of the Rules and Regulations.
