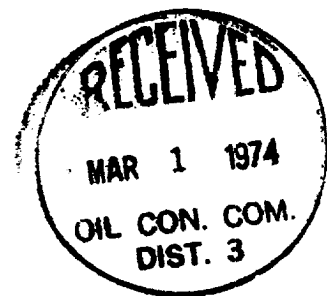

2-22: Ran two joints, 83.05', of 13-3/8" OD, 54.5# casing, set at 82' KB, cemented with 125 sacks regular Class "B" cement w/3% CaCl. Plug down at 10:20 a.m. 2-22.

2-24: Ran 41 joints, 1,603', of 9-5/8" OD, 36#, K-55, ST&C casing, set at 1579' KB. Cemented with 600 sacks Halliburton Lite cement with 1/4 pound Flocele per sack with 2% CaCl, followed with 100 sacks regular cement with 3% CaCl. Plug down at 2:00 p.m. 2-24. Tested BOP, rams and casing with 800 psi for 30 minutes each, no loss in pressure.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult State Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals for abandonment of a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State of In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between above plugs; amount, type, and method of lifting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
