The subject well was spudded September 17, 1974 and drilled to 115'. A 17-1/4" hole was reamed to 113'. The 13-3/4" casing was set at 113' and cemented with 120 sacks Class "A" with 2% CaCl on September 18, 1974. Circulated 10 sacks cement and waited on cement to set and nipple up 18-1/2 hours. Pressured casing to 600 psi for 1/2 hour OK. Hole was reduced to 12-1/4" at 113' and drilling continued to 1505'. The 9-5/8" intermediate casing was set at 1505' with 400 sacks Class "A" with 4% Gel with a tail in of 75 sacks Class "A" seat, September 23, 1974. Waited on cement to set 3 hours. Pressured 9-5/8" casing to 800 psi 1/2 hour OK. Reduced hole to 8-3/4" at 1505' and drilling continued.

Instructions
