A 12-1/4" hole was spudded at 6:30 p.m., 11-28-74 and drilled to 133'. A 17-1/4" hole was reamed to 131' and 13-3/8" casing was set at 131' with 140 sacks Type "a" cement with 2% CaCl on 11-29-74. The cement circulated. WOC 10-1/4 hours and pressured casing to 600 psi for 30 minutes OK. Reduced hole to 12-1/4" at 130' and continued drilling to 1525'. The 9-5/8" intermediate casing was set at 1525' on 12-1-74 with 450 sacks Class "B" with 4% Gel and 2 lbs. medium Tuf Plug per sack with tail in of 150 sacks Class "B" Neat. The cement circulated. WOC and tested casing to 800 psi OK. Reduced hole to 8-3/4" at 1525' and continued drilling.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations; and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
