On 3-25-75 drilled well to a depth of 6201' where Core No. 1 was cut from 6201-49'. Recovered 39' as follows: 12' limestone and shale with no permeability or porosity; 21' limestone with small vugs and scattered pinpoint porosity, bleeding oil and gas; 3' sand with large vugs and stain; and 3' limestone and shale with no show of oil or gas. Core No. 2 cut from 6249-73'. Recovered 16' as follows: 8' limestone with interbedded shale stringers; 2' broken shale, 6' limestone with interbedded shale stringers. Continued drilling well to a total depth of 6380' with the 7" casing landing at 6380' and DV tool at 4239'. Cemented first stage with 750 sacks Class "B" 50:50 Poz, 6% Gel, 2 pounds Medium Tuf Plug followed with 250 sacks Class "B" Neat on 3-28-75. WOC 18 hours. Drilled DV tool and tagged cement at 6098'. Drilled cement to 6336' FBD. Circulated hole clean.

Instructions
