Propose to drill subject well to increase oil recovery from Tocito Dome field. Samples will be taken at 10' intervals from 5965' to TD. No cores are planned. A DST is scheduled for the Barker Creek if warranted. Logs will be run from surface casing to TD. Prospective zones will be perforated and treated as necessary. Blowout preventer will be as indicated on the attached exhibit and will be tested at regular intervals. Necessary steps will be taken to protect the environment. Any gas produced during the conduct of the above described work will be flared.

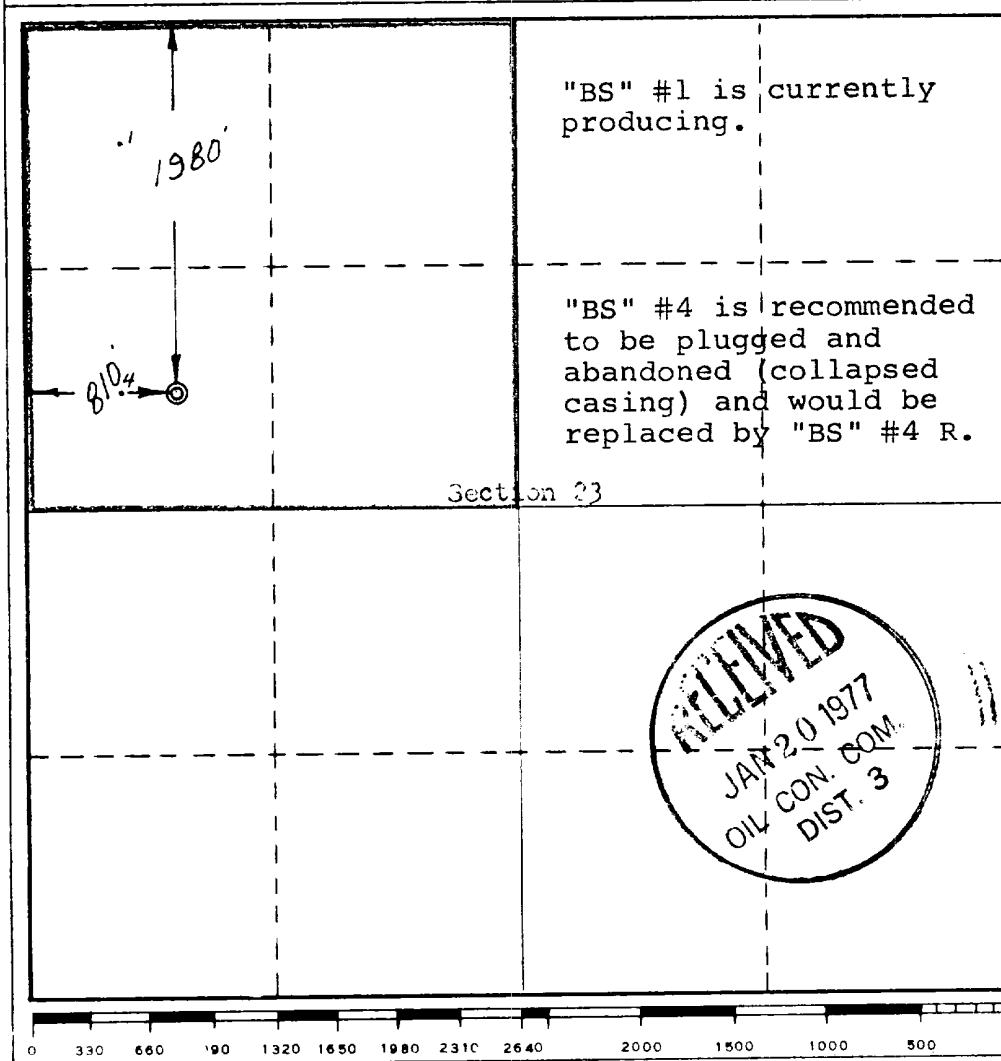

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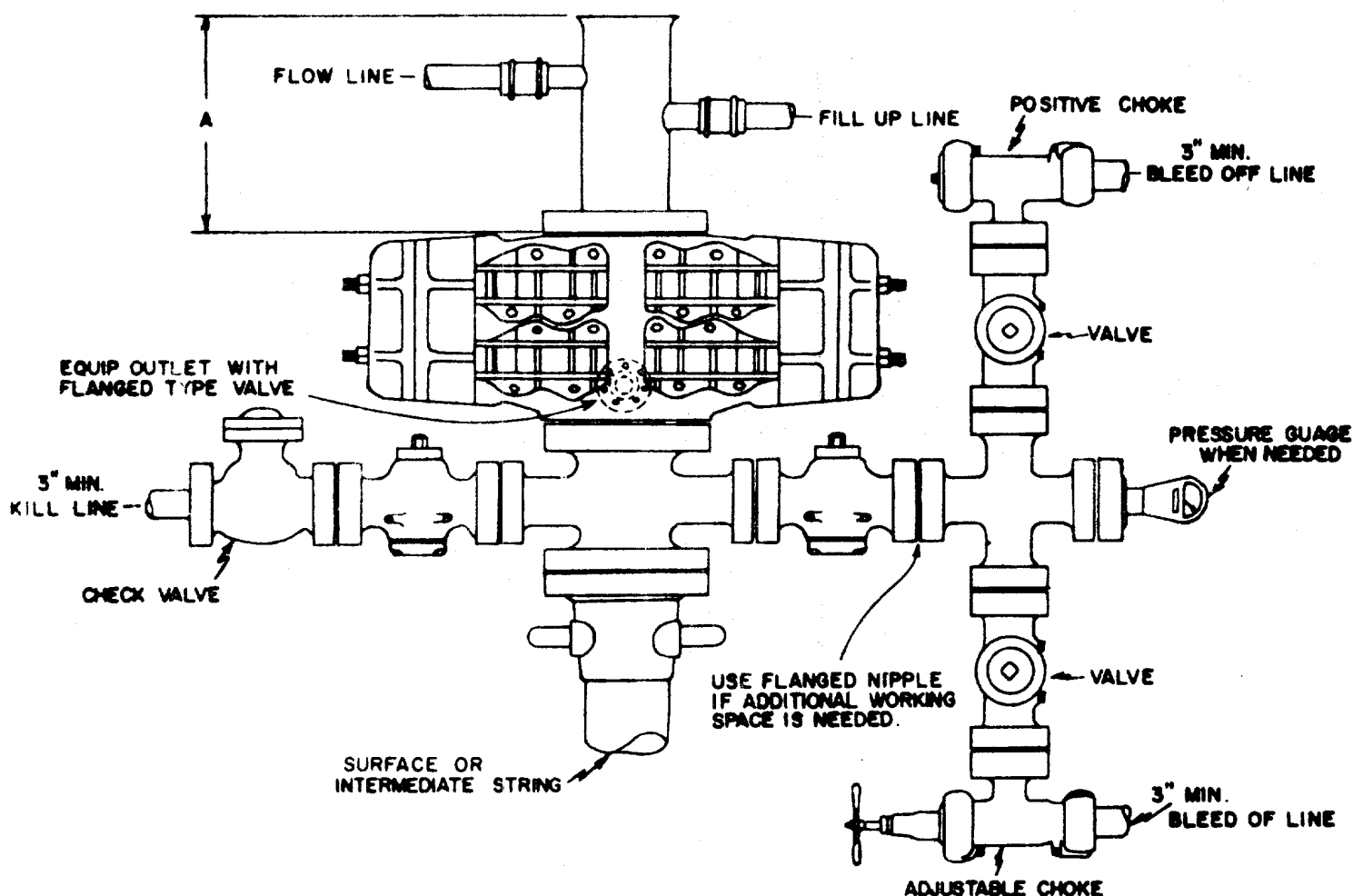

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1. *Chlorophyll a* and *Chlorophyll b* contents were determined by spectrophotometry using the method of Lichtenthal and Whistler (1987).

Minimum equipment requirements are:

1. Blowout preventers must be capable of being operated both mechanically and hydraulically. Controls must be located so that the blowout preventer can be operated outside the drilling rig substructure. All steel tubing and connections must be used between the hydraulic controls and the blowout preventer.
2. Pressure rating of the blowout preventer and associated connections must be proportional to depth and pressure expectations. Use Figure 1 as a guide in unknown areas.
3. Distance "A" must be sufficient to accommodate a Hydril preventer if required.
4. Chokes, valves, manifold piping and kill line must be flanged and designed equal to or above the pressure rating of the blowout preventer.
5. Kelly cock must be used at all times and should be checked daily.



NOTE: BLOWOUT PREVENTER MUST HAVE DOUBLE RAMS; ONE BLIND & ONE PIPE RAM OR THE EQUIPMENT MUST CONSIST OF TWO BLOWOUT PREVENTERS, ONE EQUIPPED WITH BLIND RAMS & THE OTHER WITH PIPE RAMS. ALWAYS PLACE THE BLIND RAMS IN THE TOP PREVENTER.

As requested by your office, the Surface Use Development Plan for Navajo Tribe "BS" well No. 4 R, San Juan County, New Mexico, is as follows:

1. Existing roads and exit to the location are shown on the attached plats.
2. The proposed location is adjacent to an existing road to the west, therefore no new access road will be required.
3. Offset wells to the proposed well are shown on the attached plat.
4. The flowline for subject well will run approximately 300' west to an existing flowline.
5. Water for drilling operations will be trucked from Navajo Tribe "AL" well No. 2 approximately 3 miles to the southwest.
6. No additional construction material will be required.
7. All waste material will be contained by earthen and steel pits. Earthen pits will be subsequently back-filled and buried. A portable chemical toilet will be furnished for drilling personnel.
8. No separate drill campsites are proposed.

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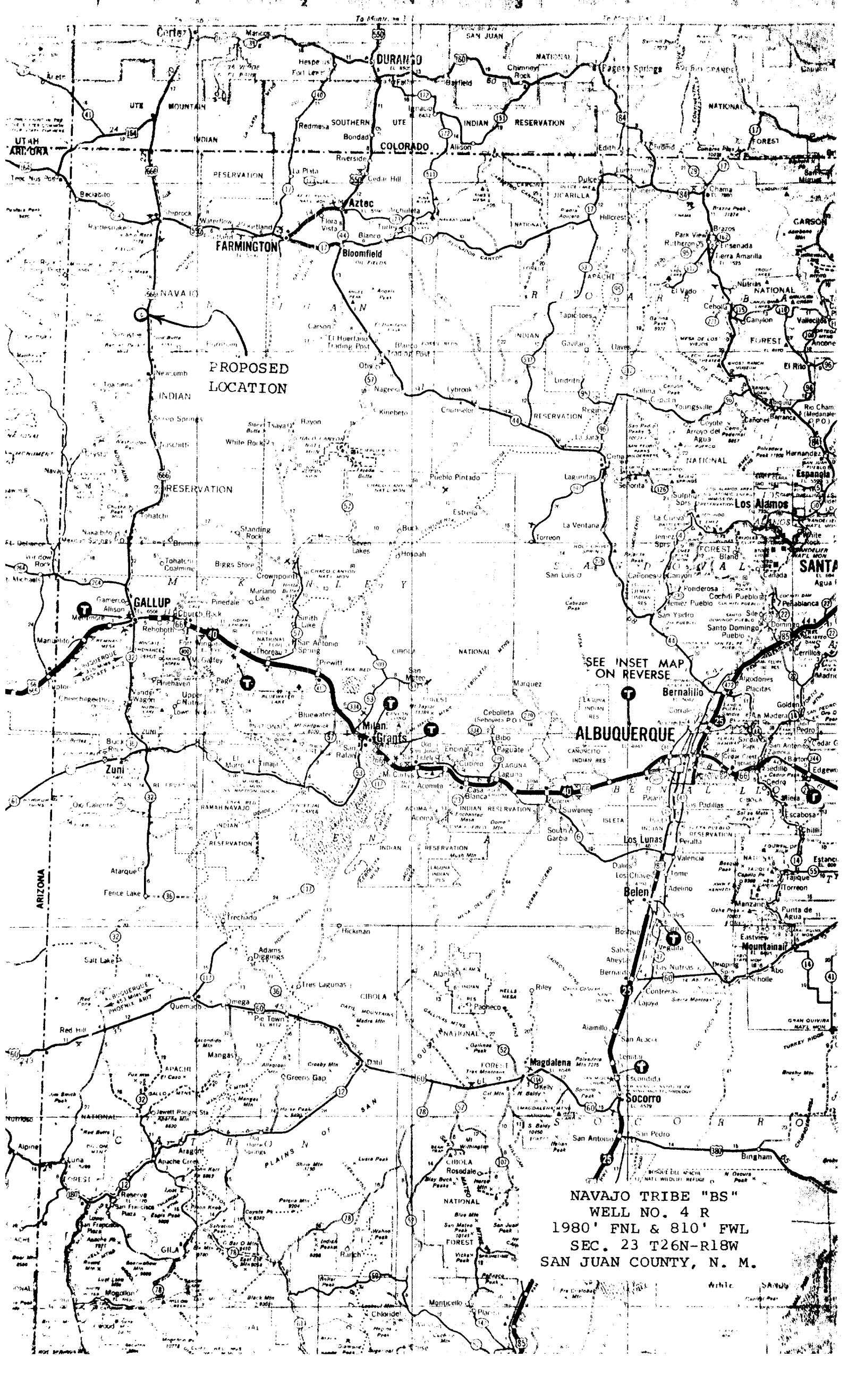
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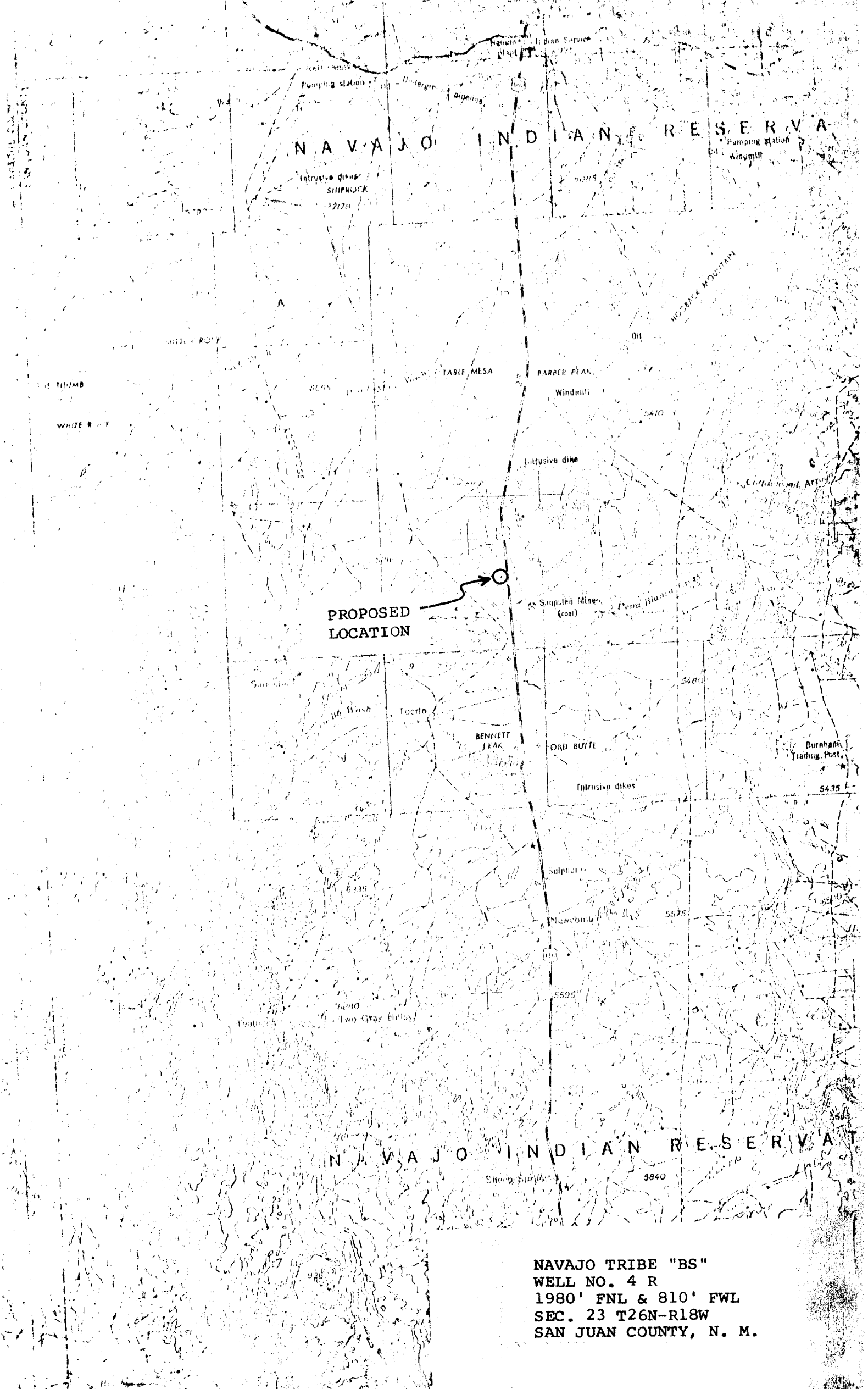
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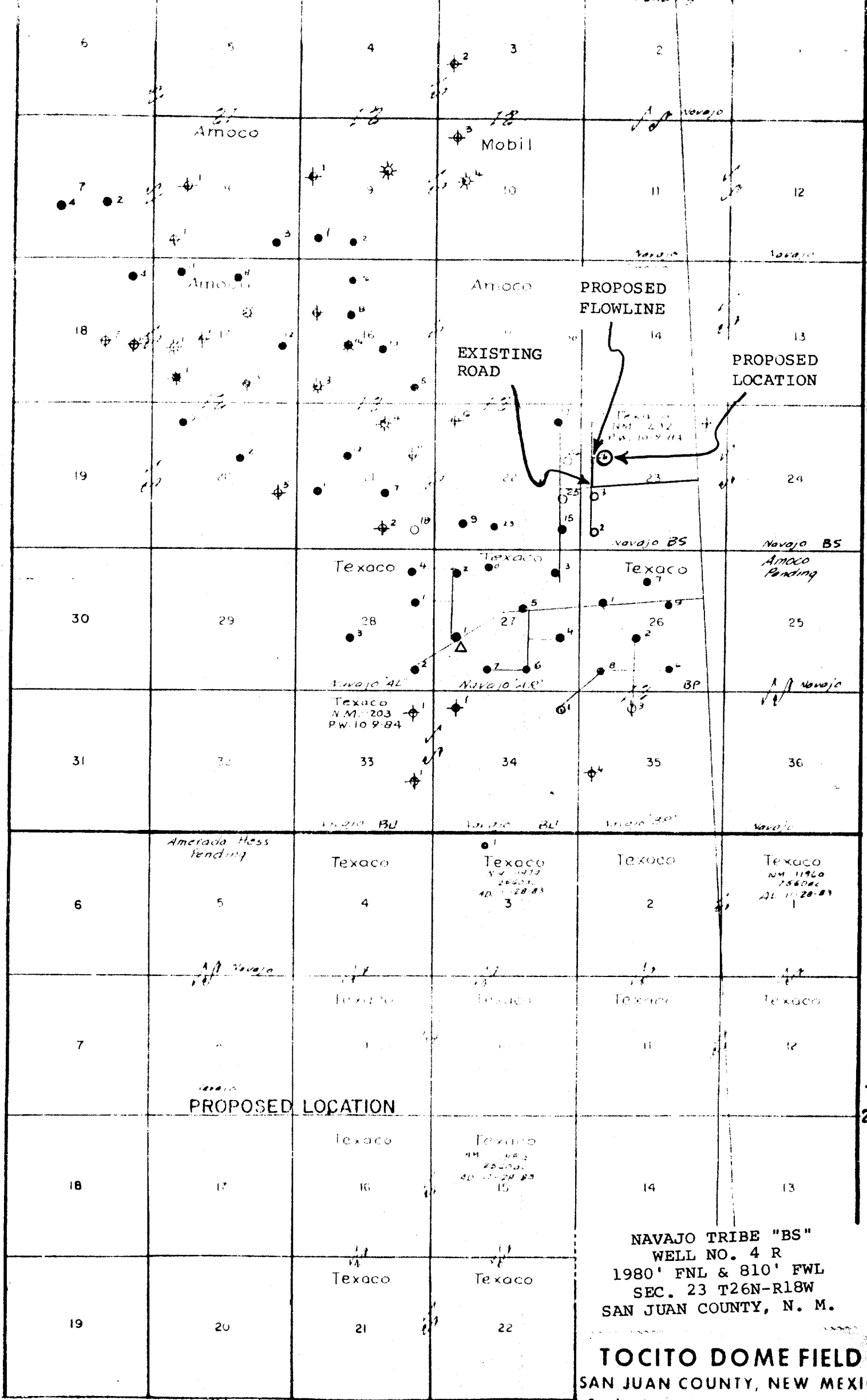
