Request permission to start long term shut-in status. Testing of this well has shown that stimulation will be required to make commercial producer. The operator has made application to drill a Fruitland Coal well on this spacing unit. The application process has been hampered by difficulties with obtaining permits on Navajo/NAPI surface containing federal minerals. If the permit process is delayed for an extended period of time, operator will opt to perforate and fracture the coal in this wellbore. If a drilling permit can be obtained, this well will be plugged and abandoned.
