## RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS INDUSTRY MANAGEMENT BOARD

Recommending to the Resources Committee of the Navajo Nation Council to Approve Four Sundry Notices for permission to construct a gas pipeline for J.K. Edwards Associates Inc. On, Over and Across Navajo Indian Irrigation Project Lands, San Juan County, New Mexico.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 5 N.T.C. 1604 (1) the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry Management Board has the authority and responsibility for the management and operation of the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry (NAPI), a wholly owned agribusiness enterprise of the Navajo Nation; and
- J.K. Edwards Associates Inc., 7415 E. Main, Farmington New Mexico, 87401 has submitted four (4) Sundry Notices for Permission to immediately lay a temporary 2 inch poly pipeline on the surface for water and gas between four gas wells and follow with a 2 inch permanent underground installation on, over and across lands within the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project (NIIP) described as:
  - Dome Federal #4, 1830 feet FNL, 1690 feet FEL, Section 17, T27N, R13W, a. NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, consisting of a pipeline 3,000 feet in length (Sundry Notice and map attached hereto as NAPI Attachment 1).
  - Ross Federal #1, 990 feet FNL, 1190 feet FEL, Section 4, T26N, R13W, b. NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, consisting of a pipeline 4,500 feet in length (Sundry Notice and map attached hereto as NAPI Attachment 2).
  - Ross Federal #2, 1520 feet FSL, 1520 feet FEL, Section 4, T26N, R13W, C. NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, consisting of a pipeline 4,670 feet in length (Sundry Notice and map attached hereto as NAPI Attachment 3).
  - Armour Federal #4 970 feet FEL, 1350 feet FEL, Section 4, T26N, R13W, d. NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, consisting of a a pipeline 4,670 feet in length (Sundry Notice and map attached hereto as NAPI Attachment 4).

The NAPI Management Board has reviewed the four Sundry Notices for Permission to lay a temporary and permanent two inch water and gas lines within the NIIP lands in consideration of the ongoing development activities, safety, and environmental concerns.

# NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- In consideration of the safety, environmental and ongoing development 1. activities on the NIIP lands, The NAPI Management Board hereby recommends the approval of the four Sundry Notice as described herein to the Resources Committee of the Navajo Nation Council for J.K. Edwards Associates Inc. to construct only the permanent 2 inches diameter gas lines as indicated on the NAPI Attachment 1,2,3,and 4 for a period of 10 years.
- J.K. Edwards Associates Inc. will have the option to renew the four Sundry Notice for an additional 10 year period subject to review and renegotiation of the terms and conditions of the Sundry Notice by NAPI Management Board.
- The NAPI Management Board further recommends that the Resources Committee of the Navajo Nation Council include the NAPI stipulations attached hereto as NAPI Attachment 5.
- The NAPI Management Board further provides that the approval of the four Sundry Notice, as described herein, shall commence within 12 months from the date of final approval, otherwise, this grant of approval shall be null and void.
