THE APPLICATION OF GREAT LAKES
CHEMICAL CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION. ORDER NO. MC-2360

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Great Lakes Chemical Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 1, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Graham Well No. 3 located in Unit P of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Largo-Chacra Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of June, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1)That application has been duly filed under the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Great Lakes Chemical Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Graham Well No. 3 located in Unit P of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Largo-Chacra Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
