

THE APPLICATION OF MESA PETROLEUM  
COMPANY FOR A TRIPLE COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2475

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Mesa Petroleum Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 9, 1978, for permission to triply complete its State Com Well No. 47 located in Unit L of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Largo-Chacra Pool, and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 29th day of November, 1978, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed triple completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Mesa Petroleum Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to triply complete its State Com Well No. 47 located in Unit L of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Largo-Chacra Pool, and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
