The development plan for surface use is as follows:

Points 1, 3, 4, 6, & 9 Vicinity map and drill site plat attached.

- Point 2. Water bars will be used on all roads where necessary. All newly constructed roads will be 15' wide.
- Point 5. Water for drilling will be trucked from the Bloomfield approximately 16 miles to the northwest.
- Point 7. A waste disposal pit will be provided for the garbage and trash.

  Location shown on drill site plat. Drilling fluids will be contained in reserve pit until such time as evaporation occurs and then pits will be covered.

- Point 10. 


