Dear Mr. Roe:

Following up on our telephone conversation on January 28th, the referenced well has been shut in past the expiration date of January 1, 2002. This well last produced in November of 2000, when it was shut in to allow production of the new Irish #4. During the shut in period Dugan proposed to contact the other operators in the pool with respect to allowing infill wells in this low production area. This was to be followed by application for hearing for exception to pool spacing rules which, in the absence of objection, might be taken under advisement. Since this procedure has not been initiated, the well needs to be brought into compliance with rule 201 which states that a well must be plugged and abandoned, or temporarily abandoned, within 90 days after being inactive for 1 year. This time limit will be over in February 2002.

To bring this well into compliance, will require at least temporary abandonment (see rule 203). This will allow time for you to pursue administrative approval for infill in the WAW Fruitland Sand/Pictured Cliffs Pool.

As requested in our last sundry, we are working with the NMOCD to allow production of this well & the Irish #4. The Irish #4 and #1J are WAW Pictured Cliffs/Fruitland Sand wells that occupy the same spacing unit. We disconnected the Irish #1J before connecting the Irish #4. The Irish #1J produces small amounts of gas, but is capable of production. We are unsure at this time how the state will handle our request to produce both wells. To pressure test the casing, a packer must be run and the casing loaded with water. Since wells in this area have very low bottom hole pressure, any water dumped into the wellbore can damage the ability to return production from this well. We request that BLM not requre a pressure test of the casing and allow adequate time for Dugan to return the well to production. We understand that if we are unable to come to an agreement with NMOCD on the spacing issue, the well will be plugged and abandoned.
