The intent is to lay a 2-inch poly-pipe from the Ross Federal #2 to the Dugan Kingfish #1, and an El Paso Natural Gas Company lateral located in the NE 1/4 of Section 3, T26N, R13W. The length of the pipeline would be approximately 5,350-feet. The pipeline will be buried a minimum depth of 48-inches. The normal operating pressure for this pipeline would be 100 PSI. The pipeline will have a certified air pressure test prior to loading with natural gas. The pipeline will be directionally drilled below the NAPI irrigation canal. The pipeline will be constructed in accordance with the Navajo Nation Right-of-way Permit and the Construction Plan, Exhibit C, of the Environmental Assessment.
