THE APPLICATION OF SUPRON ENERGY CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2886

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Supron Energy Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on June 23, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Nickson Well No. 11E located in Unit H of Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 20th day of July, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- 3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- 4. That the porposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- 5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Supron Energy Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Nickson Well No. 11E located in Unit H of Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
