

Location:

The proposed well location is in the center of the NW¼ of the NE¼ of Section 12, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The well will be 480 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from

the east line of Section 12. (Figure 1)

Access:

Same as original.

Area Surveyed:

2.07 acres.

Terrain:

Low ridge in canyon bottom with northerly drainage and

alluvial surface deposits.

Soil:

Sandy and sandy clay loam.

Vegetation:

Pinon, juniper, sagebrush, narrowleaf yucca, prickly

pear cactus, brome, ricegrass, grama.

Cultural Resources:

Site SJC-676 was found about 120 feet north of the well stake. The perimeter of the site was flagged with yellow

ribbon.

Recommendations:

Archaeological clearance is recommended with the stipulation that the site be avoided and that no disturbance of the site will occur as a result of the proposed con-

struction and drilling activities.
