Dear Frank:

The Newsom B #7E has been commingled downhole as per administrative order no. DHC-530. We recommend production be allocated as follows:

Gas: 40% Gallup

60% Dakota

Oil: 40% Gallup

60% Dakota

This is based on offset Dakota reserves of 600 to 700 MMCFG and anticipated offset Gallup reserves of 400 to 500 MMCFG. Dakota oil reserves are expected to be 12 MBO, Gallup oil reserves are expected to be 8 MBO. Offset Gallup wells are now producing 4 BOPD, Dakota wells have averaged 5 to 6 BOPD at the same time their producing life.
