Dear Mr. Buys:

A recent inspection by members of my staff showed that the following work needs to be done to bring your No. 4A Dryden LS well located 1910' FNL and 1500' FWL, sec. 12, T. 27 N., R. 8 W., lease No. NM-012200 into compliance:

1. The reserve and blow pits need additional fence posts and stretching of the wire.
2. Remove all trash from location.

Please correct the problems within 5 days of the receipt of this letter.


Failure to comply with this order will result in an assessment of damages pursuant to 43 CFR 3163.4.

Once this work has been completed, this office should be notified by Sundry Notice so that we may schedule another inspection.
