The drilling, casing and cement program will stay the same, except the total depth has changed by 30' due to ground elevation changes. 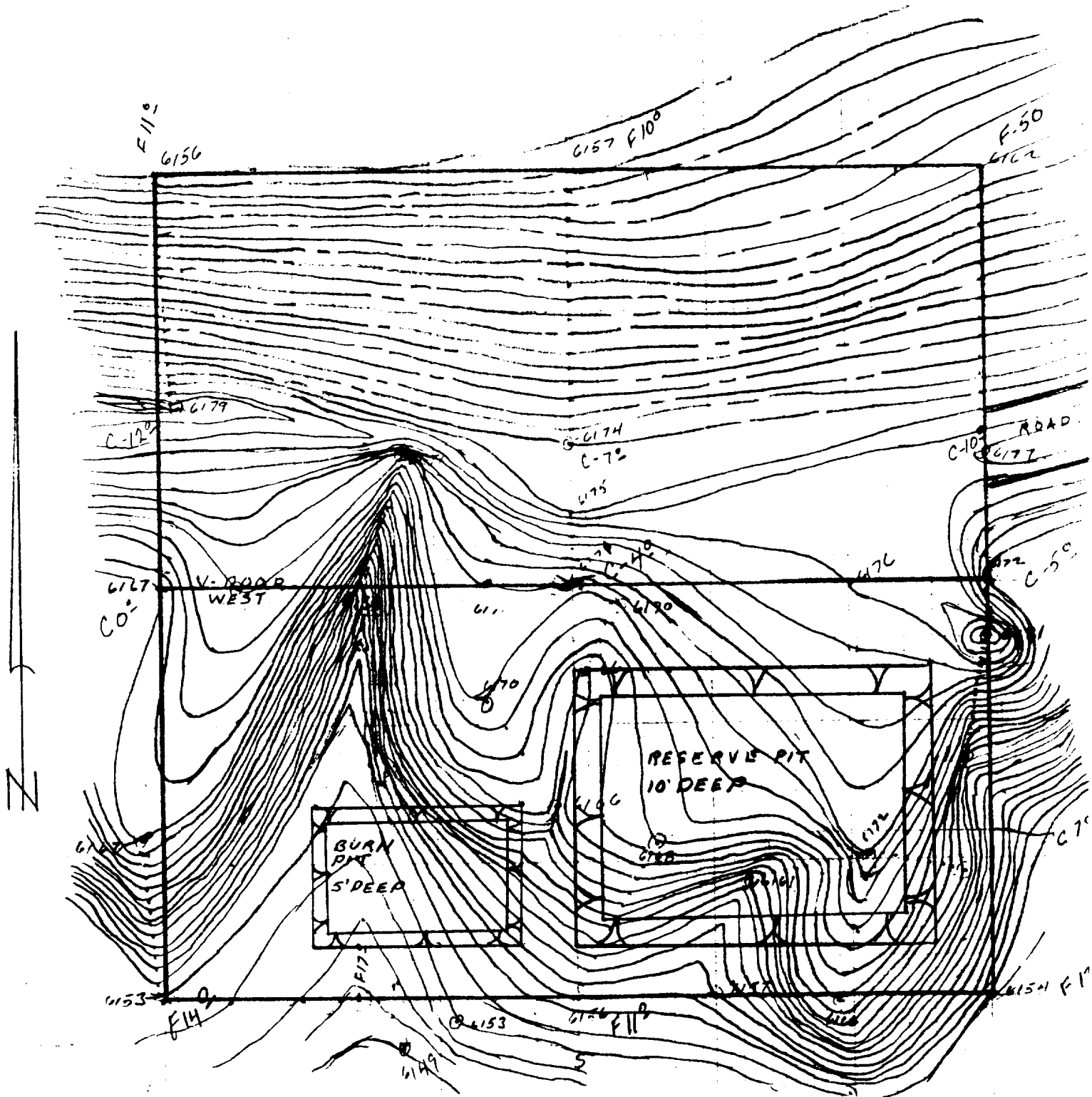

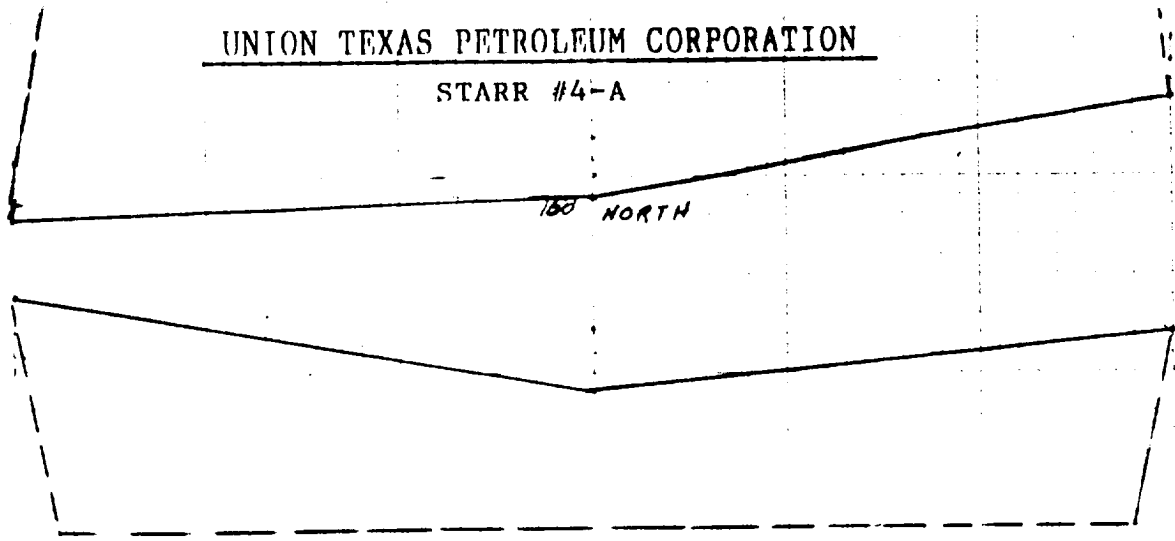
