
Plan to construct a natural gas pipeline to tie into J.P. McHugh Chaco Plant #12, which ties into the EPNG Lateral 10-A as shown on attached survey plat and topo map.

The line will be 2,307' of 3-1/2", SDR-7 polypipe. The entire line will be located on Federal Lease NM-12028 and Tribal Trust surface. Edwards Associates' line will be pressure tested to 100 psi. since it will tie into EPNG's low pressure system. There average yearly line pressure averages from 50 psi to 100 psi.

Navajo BIA clearance was approved ROW for the previous owner Nassau Resources in 1992, copy attached. Amendment is filed to change owner and type of pipe.

Cowsaround 22 #2 Natural Gas Pipeline San Juan County, New Mexico

The proposed action consists of approving a 30 foot right-of-way for a proposed natural gas pipeline. The Cowsaround 22 #2 Pipeline will be approximately 2,307.31 feet in length. The proposed pipeline will be constructed by Nassau Resource, Inc. and is to provide a 3-1/2"" pipeline system to transport natural gas from Nassau Resources, Inc., Cowsaround 22 #2 Well site to the Chaco Plant #12 . The gathering system will be buried. The system is located in Section 22, T26N, R12W (NMPM).
