Route proposed for the natural gas pipeline on previous sundry has been changed, because of tie-in costs and being unable to access the meter location. The new route will follow the access road east from well pad, then turn south still following road and will tie-in to an existing meter run along side the road. The EPNG line that we will tie-in to is still lateral 10E-#2. The route has had a new arch survey completed by San Juan College and approved by the Navajo Tribe.

The line is now 2,640' of 3 1/2" SDR-11 black polypipe, it will be buried 4 1/2' deep along side road. It will be tested at 100 psi since it will be tie in to a low pressure system.

This project is entirely within lease property.


