

Dear Mr. O'Hare:

Reference is made to your application dated January 20, 1993 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Gallegos Federal 26-13-11 Well No. 19, which was drilled in December 1992 and located 2050 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 11, Township 26 North, Range 13 West; NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.

Dear Mr. O'Hare:

We are in receipt of two letters from you, each dated January 20, 1993, serving as notice of Maralex's application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) for unorthodox locations to drill the Gallegos Federal 26-13-11 #1 and the Gallegos Federal 26-13-24 #2 wells.

Each letter advised that a copy of your application to the NMOCD was enclosed and that the NMOCD would wait for twenty (20) days after receiving the application prior to taking administrative action. Dugan Production received these letters on January 28, 1993 by certified mail (the envelope was postmarked January 26, 1993). Neither application was enclosed and your letter does not provide sufficient information for us to comment. Dugan Production does have leasehold interest adjacent to each of the proposed locations. Please provide copies of each application. If your applications do not include the objective horizon and your proposed acreage dedication, we will also need this information.

By copy of this letter, we are advising the NMOCD that we would appreciate having the opportunity to comment regarding your request for administrative approval for two unorthodox locations offsetting acreage held by Dugan Production Corp. If, in fact, the NMOCD application was mailed on or about January 20, 1993, approximately half of the comment period will be expired prior to our receiving your applications.
