The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle WAW Fruitland Sand Pictured Cliffs (Gas - 87190) and Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas - 71629) Pool production from the following leases.

Lease: Stacey Well No.1 045-29396
Description: SE/4 of Section 6, and, E-6-26-12

Lease: Stacey Well No.2 045-29411
Description: E/2 of Section 6, H-6-26-12

both in Township 26 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Production shall be allocated to each well by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling. (This is required due to the diverse ownership of the subject pools.) An allocation factor may then be determined by dividing the individual metered volumes by the total CPD metered volume.


FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

NOTE: The commingled gas shall be delivered to the El Paso Natural Gas CPD meter located in Unit Letter 'O', Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
